(3) Improvement of instruction for any of these purposes.

There is a State [Commission] ADVISORY COUNCIL on Physical Fitness in the Department.

13-404.

- (a) The State [Commission] ADVISORY COUNCIL consists of 25 members appointed by the Governor with the advice of the Secretary.
- (b) Each member shall be an individual who has experience or interest in physical fitness for both children and adults.
 - (c) (1) The term of a member is 4 years.
- (2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the State [Commission] ADVISORY COUNCIL on July 1, 1982. The terms of those members end as follows:
 - (i) 7 in 1983;
 - (ii) 6 in 1984;
 - (iii) 6 in 1985; and
 - (iv) 6 in 1986.
- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

13-405.

From among the members of the State [Commission] ADVISORY COUNCIL and with the advice of the Secretary, the Governor shall appoint a chairman for the rest of the member's term.

- (a) With the advice of the State Commission, the Secretary shall appoint an executive director, who is the chief administrative and executive officer and secretary of the State Commission.
- (b) Under the direction of the State Commission, the Executive Director has general charge of its work.]
