- (b) The State [Commission] ADVISORY COUNCIL shall meet:
  - (1) Regularly at the times and places that it determines; and
  - (2) At the call of:
    - (i) The Governor;
    - (ii) The Secretary; OR
    - (iii) The Chairman [; or
    - (iv) The Executive Director].
- (c) A member of the State [Commission] ADVISORY COUNCIL:
  - (1) May not receive compensation; but
- (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
- (d) **[**(1) With the approval of the Secretary, the State Commission may employ a staff in accordance with the State budget.
- (2) An officer or employee of the State Commission is not subject to the State Merit System Law] THE SECRETARY SHALL DESIGNATE THE STAFF NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE.

- (A) SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT ARE NECESSARY AND PROPER TO GOVERN THE PROCEDURES AND BUSINESS OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL.
- (B) BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT ADOPTS A RULE OR REGULATION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSULT WITH THE ADVISORY COUNCIL.
- (C) In addition to the duties set forth elsewhere in this subtitle, the State [Commission] ADVISORY COUNCIL shall:
- (1) [Adopt rules and regulations that are necessary and proper to govern its procedure and business;
  - (2) Maintain liaison with:
    - (i) The State Department of Education;
    - (ii) County boards of education;
    - (iii) Private and parochial schools;
    - (iv) County commissions; and
