(C) ON REQUEST OF A LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES, THE CLERK'S OFFICE SHALL DISCLOSE TO THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT THE CURRENT LAST KNOWN ADDRESS AND ALL PRIOR ADDRESSES OF THE PARENTS OF A CHILD ADJUDICATED IN NEED OF ASSISTANCE, FOR PURPOSES OF ATTEMPTING NOTIFICATION OF A PETITION FOR GUARDIANSHIP WITH THE RIGHT TO CONSENT TO ADOPTION OR LONG-TERM CARE SHORT OF ADOPTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

## Maryland Property Insurance Availability Act - Extension of Termination Date

FOR the purpose of extending the termination date of the Maryland Property Insurance Availability Act.

Article 48A - Insurance Code

Section 478-I

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 48A - Insurance Code

478-I.

This subtitle shall no longer be of any force after June 30, [1992] 1997 1996; except that obligations incurred by the Association established pursuant to the provisions of this subtitle shall not be impaired by the expiration of this subtitle and such Association shall be continued for the purpose of performing such obligations.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1 June 30, 1992.
