

CHAPTER 86

(Senate Bill 309)

AN ACT concerning

Premium Finance Companies – Dishonored Check Fee

FOR the purpose of altering the maximum fee that a premium finance company may charge for actual expenses incurred in the processing of a dishonored check.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 48A – Insurance Code

Section 486F(g)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1991 Replacement Volume and 1991 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 48A – Insurance Code

486F.

(g) A premium finance company may charge a bad check fee not to exceed [\$10] \$20 for actual expenses incurred in the processing of a dishonored check.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 87

(Senate Bill 323)

AN ACT concerning

Judges – Recall for Temporary Assignments – Charles, Prince George’s, and Harford Counties

FOR the purpose of altering the number of working days in a calendar year that certain former judges may be temporarily assigned in Charles, Prince George’s, and Harford Counties; and generally relating to the recall of certain former judges for temporary assignment in Charles, Prince George’s, and Harford Counties.

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,
