Section 57-11

Article 8 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

(1989 Edition and October, 1991 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 8 - Cecil County

57-11.

A. The Director of Parks and Recreation shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners [from a list of three (3) names submitted by the Board of Parks and Recreation]. The Director shall have a degree in recreation or a similar field or have [five (5)] 5 years' experience in parks and recreation and shall serve at the will of the Board of County Commissioners. The annual salary for the Director shall be determined by the Board of County Commissioners, except that it shall not be less than [ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.)] \$10,000.

B. The Director [shall serve] SERVES under the general direction and supervision of the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND PROVIDES STAFF SUPPORT TO THE Board of Parks and Recreation. [His] THE DIRECTOR'S duties shall consist of maintenance of equipment and facilities used in the public recreation program and in scheduling and operating programs established and adopted by the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND THE Board of Parks and Recreation.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
