- (1) Obtain written informed consent from the individual on a uniform HIV informed consent form that the Department shall develop consistent with the requirements of the Department as established by regulations adopted by the Department; and
  - (2) Provide the individual with pretest counseling, including:
- (i) Education about HIV infection and methods for preventing transmission;
  - (ii) Information about a physician's duty to warn; and
- (iii) Assistance in accessing health care available to an individual who tests positive for the HIV infection.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That regulations adopted by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene as required under Section 1 of this Act shall conform to federal government requirements under 42 U.S.C. Section 3756(F).
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

## **CHAPTER 91**

(House Bill 505)

AN ACT concerning

## Criminal Offenders - HIV Testing - Victim Notification

FOR the purpose of requiring individuals convicted of, charged with, or granted probation before judgment for committing certain offenses, upon the request of a victim, to furnish a blood sample to be tested for the presence of the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) and any other identified causative agent of the acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS) under certain circumstances; requiring a court to conduct a certain hearing prior to issuing an order for testing under certain circumstances; requiring a court to issue an order for testing when an individual is convicted of or granted probation before judgment for committing an offense; requiring a local health officer to collect a blood sample, conduct testing of the blood sample in a certain manner, and provide certain counseling under certain circumstances; requiring a local health officer to provide a certain notification to certain individuals; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to adopt certain regulations in conformance with certain federal requirements; requiring certain persons to notify a victim of the provisions of this Act under certain circumstances; allowing a victim to disclose certain information to certain other individuals for a certain purpose; providing a certain penalty for the disclosure of certain test results by certain persons under certain circumstances; providing a certain exception to certain informed consent provisions of law;
