- (ii) The time required for delivery;
- (iii) The purpose for which required;
- (iv) The competence and responsibility of the bidder; and
- (v) The ability of the bidder to perform the contract satisfactorily.
- (2) The board of trustees may reject any and all bids and readvertise for other bids.
- [(d)](E) (1) In this subsection, the terms "minority business enterprise" and "minority individual" have the meanings stated in § 14-301(e) of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- (2) In Montgomery County, by resolution and by implementing rules and regulations, the Board of Trustees of Montgomery Community College shall establish a mandatory minority business utilization program to facilitate the participation of responsible certified minority business enterprises in contracts awarded by the Board of Trustees of Montgomery Community College in accordance with competitive bidding requirements.
- [(e)](F) In Montgomery County, the Board of Trustees of Montgomery Community College may:
- (1) Provide in its bid specifications that a product grown, mined, or manufactured in the Republic of South Africa may be rejected; and
- (2) Reject a bid for a product grown, mined, or manufactured in the Republic of South Africa.
- [(f)](G) A contract entered into or purchase made in violation of this section is void.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 97

(Senate Bill 601)

AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - Sheriff

FOR the purpose of requiring the Sheriff of Cecil County to appoint a deputy director of the detention center and a director of law enforcement; providing that these individuals will serve at the pleasure of the Sheriff and may be removed with or without cause; exempting these individuals from certain provisions of law applicable
