AN ACT concerning

Procurement - Public Work Contracts - Preference for Bidders Who Employ Maryland Residents Requirements - Nonresident Bidders

FOR the purpose of requiring a unit of State government to grant a certain percentage preference to a bidder for a public work contract if the bidder will employ a certain percentage of Maryland residents for the duration of the project; defining certain terms; and generally relating to a preference system for certain public work contracts certain nonresident bidders to submit with certain proposals certain statutory information pertaining to the reciprocity procedures of the bidders' resident state.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
 - (2) "Preference" includes:
 - (i) a percentage preference;
 - (ii) an employee residency requirement; or
