(b) A juror shall receive the per diem amount stated in this section for each day the juror attends court as a juror in:

(18) Queen Anne's County — \$15 expense money; [20 cents] mileage allowance AS SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; if a juror's service extends past 6:00 p.m. on any day, the juror shall receive an additional \$15 expense money.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 109

(House Bill 135)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County – Sanitary District – Executive Director and Assistant Executive Director

FOR the purpose of requiring the County Commissioners of Washington County to appoint an executive director of the Washington County Sanitary District; authorizing the County Commissioners to appoint an assistant executive director of the District; providing that the executive director is chief operating officer of the District and is responsible for certain duties; providing that the compensation of the executive director and assistant executive director is set by the County Commissioners, but paid by the District; providing that the executive director and assistant executive director are county employees; authorizing the County Commissioners to remove for just cause the executive director or assistant executive director after reviewing any recommendations of the Commission of the District; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to the employment of an executive director and assistant executive director of the Washington County Sanitary District.
