

(ii) the amount of the property tax credit, based on a percentage of the cost of any new construction or of any improvement to existing property, and not based on the increase in the assessment; and

(iii) the duration of the tax credit.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.

**CHAPTER 112**

**(House Bill 138)**

AN ACT concerning

**Washington County - On-Site Utility Contractors - Licensure**

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Washington County to adopt by ordinance or resolution a licensing scheme for on-site utility contractors who perform certain plumbing work; providing that the County Commissioners may set a license fee and may require a performance bond; providing that an individual licensed in Washington County does not need a license to provide plumbing services in order to perform certain work; *making this Act an emergency measure*; and generally relating to the licensing of on-site utility contractors in Washington County.
