- (ii) the amount of the property tax credit, based on a percentage of the cost of any new construction or of any improvement to existing property, and not based on the increase in the assessment; and
 - (iii) the duration of the tax credit.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 112

(House Bill 138)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - On-Site Utility Contractors - Licensure

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Washington County to adopt by ordinance or resolution a licensing scheme for on-site utility contractors who perform certain plumbing work; providing that the County Commissioners may set a license fee and may require a performance bond; providing that an individual licensed in Washington County does not need a license to provide plumbing services in order to perform certain work; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the licensing of on-site utility contractors in Washington County.
