amount involved in the contract exceeds [\$12,000] \$20,000 \$15,000 without advertising for bids in 1 or more newspapers published in the county. The publication of that advertisement shall appear at least once a week prior to the date on which bids are to be filed.

- (b) Any contract of sale shall be awarded to the highest responsible bidder; any contract of purchase or other expenditure shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder. However, the County Commissioners may reject any [and all bids] BID.
- (c) (1) Any contract entered into in violation of the provisions of this section is void.
 - (2) [However, the] THE provisions of this section do not apply to:
- (i) Any contract or other transaction involving the deposit of county funds in any authorized State or federal banking institution [and do not apply to necessary];
 - (II) NECESSARY repairs made in case of emergency; or

[(ii)](III) The purchase of tangible personal property at a public auction.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

(House Bill 146)
