(House Bill 197)

AN ACT concerning

Health Occupations – Destruction of Medical Records

FOR the purpose of altering the scope of provisions requiring certain health care providers to comply with certain procedures regarding the destruction of medical records; providing for certain technical changes; and generally relating to the destruction of medical records.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
