SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

3 - 303.

- (a) To apply for a license, an applicant shall submit to the Board at least 15 days before an examination:
- (1) An application on the form the Board requires that includes information of the applicant's:
 - (i) Educational history;
 - (ii) Experience in health care;
 - (iii) Hours and courses taken during chiropractic studies;
 - (iv) Training or studies in related fields; and
 - (v) Clinical experience;
- (2) Certified transcripts that demonstrate compliance with the college credit requirements of § 3-302 of this subtitle;
 - (3) Proof of any degrees or certification alleged;
 - (4) Satisfactory evidence of good moral character; and
 - (5) An application fee set by the Board.
 - (b) An application shall be signed by the applicant and verified.
- (c) The applicant shall pay an application fee [of \$25] SET BY THE BOARD for any subsequent application and examination.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1992.
