- (S) "RETIREMENT" MEANS WITHDRAWAL FROM EMPLOYMENT WITH AN EMPLOYER WITH A RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE GRANTED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE.

The phrase "employment with an employer" is substituted for "active service" for clarification.

- (T) (1) "RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE" MEANS THE ALLOWANCE THAT IS PAYABLE AT THE TIME OF WITHDRAWAL FROM EMPLOYMENT WITH AN EMPLOYER.
  - (2) "RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE" INCLUDES:
    - (I) A SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE; AND
    - (II) A DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE.
  - COMMITTEE NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 73B, § 1(18). This definition allows the distinction between an allowance that is received at the time of withdrawal from employment and a vested allowance that is deferred.
- (U) "SEVERAL FUNDS" MEANS THE ANNUITY SAVINGS FUNDS, ACCUMULATION FUNDS, AND EXPENSE FUNDS ESTABLISHED BY § 1–301 OF THIS TITLE.

The phrase "and expense funds" is added to include the three types of funds established for each system.
