- (3) THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND;
- (4) THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR TEACHERS OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND;
- (5) THE STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND;
  - (6) THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM;
- (7) THE NATURAL RESOURCES LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM;
- (8) THE JUDGES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND;
- (9) THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' PENSION SYSTEM;
- (10) THE LEGISLATIVE RETIREMENT PLAN OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND AS PROVIDED IN THE JOINT RESOLUTION BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY COMPENSATION COMMISSION UNDER ARTICLE III, § 15 OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION; AND
- (11) ANY OTHER SYSTEM OR SUBSYSTEM ADMINISTERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.
  - COMMITTEE NOTE: This section is new language derived from the provisions establishing the several systems (Art. 73B, §§ 2, 82, 112, and 142 and Art. 88B, § 50), and from the definition of several systems in former Art. 73B, § 158(1).
    - Items (7) and (9) are new language necessary as a result of the addition of the 2 new systems by Chapters 479 and 580 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1989.
    - Item (10) is new language to clarify that the Legislative Retirement Plan is one of the several systems even though its provisions are found in the Joint Resolution of the General Assembly Compensation Commission and are not contained in this article. ## 1-103. BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

- (A) THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE GENERAL ADMINISTRATION AND PROPER OPERATION OF THE SEVERAL SYSTEMS IS VESTED IN THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR MARYLAND STATE RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEMS. THE BOARD SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING 15 MEMBERS:
  - (1) THE STATE COMPTROLLER, EX OFFICIO;
