- (1) THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT PLAN OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND SHALL BE COMBINED; AND
- (2) THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR TEACHERS OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND SHALL BE COMBINED.

1–307. PAYMENTS BY COUNTY TO STATE FOR EMPLOYEES OF BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS.

- (A) FOR PERMANENT EMPLOYEES OF BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS WHO BECAME MEMBERS OF THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, THE COUNTY, WHERE THE MEMBER IS EMPLOYED, SHALL PAY TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM THE CONTRIBUTIONS REQUIRED TO BE MADE BY THE STATE ON BEHALF OF THE SERVICE OF THE MEMBER.
- (B) THE COUNTY SHALL DEDUCT THE APPROPRIATE CONTRIBUTION REQUIRED TO BE MADE BY THE MEMBER ON ACCOUNT OF THE SERVICE FROM THE COMPENSATION PAYABLE TO THE MEMBER AND SHALL PAY THESE AMOUNTS TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.
