

COMPENSATION IS PROVIDED BY STATE APPROPRIATION OR WHOSE COMPENSATION IS PAID FROM STATE FUNDS.

(2) "EMPLOYEE" ALSO INCLUDES:

(I) ANY APPOINTED OR ELECTED OFFICIAL OF THIS STATE;

(II) ANY OF THE FOLLOWING APPOINTED OR ELECTED OFFICIALS OF EACH COUNTY:

1. CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT;
2. REGISTER OF WILLS;
3. STATE'S ATTORNEY; AND
4. SHERIFF;

(III) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE OFFICE OF THE SHERIFF OF BALTIMORE CITY;

(IV) ANY ASSESSOR UNLESS THE ASSESSOR IS A MEMBER OF A RETIREMENT OR PENSION SYSTEM OPERATED BY A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE; AND

(V) THE EMPLOYEES OF A BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS.

(3) "EMPLOYEE" DOES NOT INCLUDE:

(I) ANY PERSON WHO IS A MEMBER OF OR ENTITLED TO BE A MEMBER OF ANY OTHER SYSTEM OF THE SEVERAL SYSTEMS;

(II) ANY CLASS OF EMPLOYEE WHOSE COMPENSATION IS PROVIDED OR PAID ONLY PARTLY BY THE STATE;

(III) ANY EMPLOYEE WHO SERVES ON A CONTRACTUAL OR TEMPORARY BASIS; OR

(IV) ANY PERSON WHO WAS EMPLOYED PURSUANT TO A FEDERAL PUBLIC SERVICE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM.

(4) IN ANY CASE OF DOUBT, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL DETERMINE WHETHER ANY PERSON IS AN EMPLOYEE REGARDLESS OF THE METHOD OF PAYMENT.

COMMITTEE NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 73B, § 1(3).

In paragraph (3)(iv) of this subsection, the term "federal Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA)" is deleted as obsolete since there is no longer a federal CETA program.
