- (4) THE PERSON RETURNS TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES THE ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS TOGETHER WITH THE INTEREST PREVIOUSLY REFUNDED;
- (5) THE PERSON PAYS TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ANY APPRECIATION OR EARNINGS IN THE PERSON'S INDIVIDUAL RETIREMENT ACCOUNT AND OTHER AMOUNTS THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES; AND
- (6) THE PERSON SATISFIES ANY AND ALL ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.
- (B) A PERSON DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A)(1), (2), AND (3) OF THIS SECTION OR THE BENEFICIARY OF SUCH A PERSON MAY ELECT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND UPON THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES DETERMINES.

2-207. CONTINUATION OF MEMBERSHIP.

- (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, ANY PERSON WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM, ESTABLISHED BY THIS TITLE, ON DECEMBER 31, 1979, AND DOES NOT AT ANY TIME ELECT TO BE A MEMBER OF THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND SHALL, AS A CONDITION OF THAT PERSON'S EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT, BE ENTITLED TO REMAIN A MEMBER OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM WITHOUT CHANGE IN THE BENEFITS PROVIDED IN THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM AS OF DECEMBER 31, 1979.
- (B) ANY PERSON RECEIVING BENEFITS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE ON DECEMBER 31, 1979, SHALL CONTINUE TO RECEIVE THE BENEFITS AS PROVIDED IN THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM AS OF DECEMBER 31, 1979. THESE BENEFITS SHALL INCLUDE BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO:
- (1) THE ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICE RETIREMENT UPON COMPLETION OF 30 YEARS SERVICE OR ATTAINMENT OF AGE 60;
- (2) THE ELIGIBILITY FOR A REDUCED SERVICE RETIREMENT UPON COMPLETION OF A CERTAIN LENGTH OF SERVICE;
- (3) THE SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF ONE FIFTY-FIFTH OF AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION:
- (4) THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES PROVIDED FOR ORDINARY OR ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY;
