RETIREE'S RETIREMENT AND THE RETIREE'S AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION PLUS \$5,000, AND IF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES CONCURS IN THE REPORT, THEN THE AMOUNT OF THE RETIREE'S PENSION SHALL BE REDUCED.

- (III) IF THE ORDINARY DISABILITY RETIREE'S EARNING CAPACITY IS LATER CHANGED, THE AMOUNT OF THE RETIREE'S PENSION MAY BE FURTHER MODIFIED, PROVIDED THAT THE NEW PENSION MAY NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF THE PENSION ORIGINALLY GRANTED.
- (IV) THE AMOUNT OF THE PENSION REDUCTION REQUIRED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH AND ALLOWED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE ONE DOLLAR FOR EVERY TWO DOLLARS BY WHICH THE RETIREE'S CURRENT COMPENSATION EXCEEDS THE LIMITATION PROVIDED UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH.
- (V) THE PENSION REDUCTION REQUIRED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH AND ALLOWED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY TO AN ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY RETIREE.
- (2) A RETIREE RESTORED TO ACTIVE SERVICE AT A SALARY LESS THAN THE AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION UPON THE BASIS OF WHICH THE RETIREE WAS RETIRED SHALL NOT BECOME A MEMBER OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNTIL THE RETIREE'S SALARY IS AT LEAST EQUAL TO SUCH AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION.
- (G) (1) IF A DISABILITY RETIREE UNDER THE AGE OF 60 IS RESTORED TO ACTIVE SERVICE AND IF THE RETIREE'S ANNUAL COMPENSATION THEN OR AT ANY TIME PRIOR TO THE AGE OF 60 IS EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN THE RETIREE'S AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION AT RETIREMENT:
 - (I) THE RETIREE'S ALLOWANCE SHALL CEASE;
- (II) THE RETIREE SHALL AGAIN BECOME A MEMBER OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM;
- (III) THE RETIREE SHALL CONTRIBUTE THEREAFTER AT THE SAME RATE THE RETIREE PAID PRIOR TO DISABILITY;
- (IV) PREVIOUS CREDITABLE SERVICE SHALL BE RESTORED TO FULL FORCE AND EFFECT; AND
- (V) ON THE RETIREE'S SUBSEQUENT RETIREMENT THE RETIREE SHALL BE CREDITED WITH ALL THE SERVICE AS A MEMBER CREDITABLE TO THE MEMBER AT THE TIME OF RETIREMENT.
