- (2) IF A MEMBER IN SERVICE DIES WHILE PURCHASING CREDIT UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1) OR (2) OF THIS SECTION THROUGH A PAYROLL DEDUCTION AND THE CREDIT QUALIFIES FOR BENEFITS UNDER § 3–414(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE MEMBER'S SURVIVING SPOUSE MAY PAY FOR THE APPROPRIATE FINAL ADJUSTMENT FOR THE CREDIT.

## SUBTITLE 4. BENEFITS.

## 3-401. SERVICE RETIREMENT.

- (A) A MEMBER MAY RETIRE IF:
  - (1) ON OR BEFORE THE DATE OF RETIREMENT THE MEMBER:
- (I) HAS ATTAINED AT LEAST 30 YEARS OF CREDITABLE SERVICE; OR
  - (II) IS AT LEAST 60 YEARS OLD; AND
- (2) THE MEMBER HAS SUBMITTED A WRITTEN APPLICATION TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES STATING THE DATE ON WHICH THE MEMBER DESIRES TO RETIRE.
- (B) THE ALLOWANCE UNDER THIS SECTION IS A SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE EQUAL TO 1/55 OF THE MEMBER'S AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION MULTIPLIED BY THE NUMBER OF YEARS OF CREDITABLE SERVICE.
