

In subsections (c)(1) and (d)(2) of this section, the former words "deceptive" and "fraudulent" are deleted as included in the words "unlawful" and "misleading".

In subsections (c)(2) and (d)(5) of this section, the former word "knowledgeable" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the word "informed".

In subsection (d)(3) of this section, the former phrase "of the law" is deleted as surplusage.

In subsection (d)(4) of this section, the word "individual" is substituted for the former word "person" because this subsection applies only to human beings.

In subsection (e)(3) of this section, the former words "[p]ublic information" are deleted as surplusage.

Former Art. 56, § 215(e)(1), which provided that the program shall make available to the public a toll-free telephone number for obtaining information and reporting alleged violations, is deleted as implicit in light of subsection (d)(3) of this section.

6-202. SERVICE ON FOREIGN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS OR REPRESENTATIVES.

(A) "FOREIGN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION OR REPRESENTATIVE" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "FOREIGN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION OR REPRESENTATIVE" MEANS A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION OR CHARITABLE REPRESENTATIVE WHO:

- (1) HAS ITS PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS OUT OF STATE; OR
- (2) IS ORGANIZED UNDER THE LAWS OF ANOTHER STATE.

(B) SECRETARY OF STATE AS AGENT.

BY SOLICITING A CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTION IN THE STATE, A FOREIGN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION OR REPRESENTATIVE IRREVOCABLY APPOINTS THE SECRETARY OF STATE AS AGENT TO RECEIVE A SUBPOENA, SUMMONS, OR OTHER PROCESS THAT IS:

- (1) ISSUED IN AN ACTION BROUGHT UNDER THIS TITLE; AND
- (2) DIRECTED TO:

(I) THE FOREIGN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION OR REPRESENTATIVE; OR
