

(9) WITH THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE IF THE MEMBER IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR VESTING IN THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM;

(10) WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT;

(11) WITH AN OUT-OF-STATE MUNICIPALITY;

(12) WITH THE STATE; OR

(13) WITH A PUBLIC SCHOOL AS A TEACHER.

(H) ANY MEMBER OF THE PENSION SYSTEM WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY SERVED IN A POSITION AS DESCRIBED IN § 4-201(C) OF THIS TITLE MAY RECEIVE CREDIT FOR ELIGIBILITY SERVICE FOR THE PERIOD OF SUCH SERVICE UPON MAKING IN A SINGLE PAYMENT, THE CONTRIBUTIONS, WITH INTEREST, WHICH THE BOARD DEEMS APPROPRIATE.

(I) (1) ANY MEMBER OF THE PENSION SYSTEM WHO IS EMPLOYED BY A MEMBER OF THE SENATE OR HOUSE OF DELEGATES OF MARYLAND AND HAS WORKED AT LEAST 130 DAYS PER YEAR AS A LEGISLATIVE EMPLOYEE BEFORE BECOMING A MEMBER IS CONSIDERED TO BE A PERMANENT PART-TIME LEGISLATIVE EMPLOYEE AND SHALL RECEIVE CREDIT FOR ELIGIBILITY SERVICE FOR THAT PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT IF THE MEMBER PAYS TO THE PENSION SYSTEM:

(I) FOR ANY PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1979, THE SUM OF:

1. THE AMOUNT THAT THE MEMBER WOULD HAVE BEEN REQUIRED TO CONTRIBUTE FOR THAT PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT; AND

2. INTEREST ON THE MEMBER'S CONTRIBUTIONS, COMPOUNDED ANNUALLY; AND

(II) FOR ANY PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1980, THE SUM OF:

1. THE AMOUNT THAT THE MEMBER WOULD HAVE BEEN REQUIRED TO CONTRIBUTE FOR THAT PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT;

2. THE AMOUNT THAT THE STATE WOULD HAVE HAD TO CONTRIBUTE FOR THAT MEMBER FOR THAT PERIOD OF EMPLOYMENT; AND

3. INTEREST ON THE MEMBER'S AND STATE'S CONTRIBUTIONS, COMPOUNDED ANNUALLY.

(2) (I) THE RATE OF INTEREST TO BE PAID IS THE AVERAGE RATE OF INTEREST FOR THE 5 YEARS PRECEDING THE YEAR OF PAYMENT.
