

(I) HAS ATTAINED AT LEAST 15 YEARS BUT LESS THAN 30 YEARS OF ELIGIBILITY SERVICE; AND

(II) IS AT LEAST 55 BUT LESS THAN 62 YEARS OLD.

(B) THE ALLOWANCE UNDER THIS SECTION IS A REDUCED SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE EQUAL TO THE SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE COMPUTED, AS PROVIDED IN § 4-401 OF THIS SUBTITLE ON THE BASIS OF THE MEMBER'S AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION AND CREDITABLE SERVICE AT THE TIME OF EARLY RETIREMENT, REDUCED BY 1/2 OF 1 PERCENT FOR EACH MONTH BY WHICH THE MEMBER'S EARLY RETIREMENT DATE PRECEDES THE DATE THE MEMBER ATTAINS AGE 62.

4-403. EFFECT OF LATE FILING OF APPLICATION.

A FORMER MEMBER WHO FAILS TO SUBMIT A WRITTEN APPLICATION BEFORE TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP IN THE SYSTEM IS RETIRED WITHOUT RETROACTIVE PAYMENTS ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH FOLLOWING RECEIPT OF A WRITTEN APPLICATION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, IF THE FORMER MEMBER:

(1) IS OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE FOR A SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER § 4-401 OR § 4-402 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(2) HAS NOT WITHDRAWN ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE FORMER MEMBER.

4-404. ORDINARY AND ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY RETIREMENT.

(A) (1) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL GRANT AN ORDINARY DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE TO A MEMBER IF:

(I) THE MEMBER HAS ATTAINED AT LEAST 5 YEARS OF ELIGIBILITY SERVICE;

(II) AN APPLICATION HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

1. BY THE MEMBER; OR

2. IF THE MEMBER IS UNABLE TO APPLY, BY THE MEMBER'S DEPARTMENT HEAD; AND
