6-206. RECIPROCAL AGREEMENTS.

THE SECRETARY OF STATE MAY MAKE RECIPROCAL AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER STATES TO:

(1) EXCHANGE INFORMATION ABOUT CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS OR CHARITABLE REPRESENTATIVES; OR

(2) ACCEPT SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR INFORMATION SUBMITTED TO THOSE STATES BY CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS OR CHARITABLE REPRESENTATIVES INSTEAD OF THE INFORMATION REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED UNDER THIS TITLE.

6-207. DISPOSITION OF MONEY.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL PAY ALL MONEY COLLECTED UNDER THIS TITLE INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

SUBTITLE 3. CHARITABLE REPRESENTATIVES.

6-301. REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

(A) IN GENERAL.

A PERSON MUST BE REGISTERED APPROPRIATELY WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE WHENEVER THE PERSON ACTS AS AN ASSOCIATE SOLICITOR, A PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR, OR A FUND-RAISING COUNSEL.

(B) GRACE PERIOD FOR ASSOCIATE SOLICITOR.

IF, WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER A PERSON STARTS EMPLOYMENT AS AN ASSOCIATE SOLICITOR, THE PERSON'S NAME IS SUBMITTED TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBTITLE, THE PERSON IS DEEMED TO BE REGISTERED ON THE FIRST DAY OF EMPLOYMENT.
