6-302. APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION.

(A) IN GENERAL.

AN APPLICANT FOR REGISTRATION AS A PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR OR FUND-RAISING COUNSEL SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AN APPLICATION UNDER OATH ON THE FORM THAT THE SECRETARY OF STATE PROVIDES;

(2) CONSENT IN WRITING TO THE JURISDICTION AND VENUE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY IN ACTIONS BROUGHT UNDER THIS TITLE; AND

(3) PAY TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AN APPLICATION FEE OF:

(I) \$100 FOR REGISTRATION AS A FUND-RAISING COUNSEL; OR

(II) \$200 FOR REGISTRATION AS A PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR.

(B) SINGLE FEES FOR FUND-RAISING COUNSEL AND PROFESSIONAL SOLICITORS.

(1) AN APPLICANT FOR REGISTRATION AS A FUND-RAISING COUNSEL MAY REGISTER AND PAY A SINGLE APPLICATION FEE OF \$100 TO COVER ALL OF THE APPLICANT'S OFFICERS, AGENTS, MEMBERS, AND EMPLOYEES WHO WORK IN FUND-RAISING, IF THE APPLICANT LISTS IN THE APPLICATION THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF EACH OF THEM.

(2) AN APPLICANT FOR REGISTRATION AS A PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR MAY REGISTER AND PAY A SINGLE APPLICATION FEE OF \$200 TO COVER ALL OF THE APPLICANT'S OFFICERS, AGENTS, MEMBERS, ASSOCIATE SOLICITORS, AND EMPLOYEES WHO WORK IN FUND-RAISING, IF THE APPLICANT:
