

7-103. LEGISLATIVE POLICY.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, THE ADMINISTRATION, MANAGEMENT, AND FUNDING OF THE BENEFITS FOR CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS AND SECURITY ATTENDANTS AT CLIFTON T. PERKINS HOSPITAL CENTER ARE THE SAME AS THOSE PROVIDED BY THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND.

COMMITTEE NOTE: This section formerly appeared as Art. 73B, § 156(e).

The phrase "Except as otherwise provided in this title" is added to reflect that some of the provisions of law concerning the operation of this retirement system have been added to this title as explicit provisions.

In this section and throughout this title, the term "security attendants" is substituted for "maximum security attendants" to reflect the actual term used for the positions.

SUBTITLE 2. MEMBERSHIP.

7-201. MEMBERSHIP.

THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE MEMBERS OF THIS RETIREMENT SYSTEM AS A CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT BY THE STATE:

(1) ANY CORRECTIONAL OFFICER SERVING IN ANY OF THE FIRST 6 JOB CLASSIFICATIONS, EXCEPT FOR A FORMER BALTIMORE CITY JAIL EMPLOYEE WHO DID NOT ELECT TO BECOME A MEMBER UNDER § 1-507 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND

(2) ANY SECURITY ATTENDANT AT CLIFTON T. PERKINS HOSPITAL CENTER.

COMMITTEE NOTE: This section formerly appeared as Art. 73B, § 156(a)(1).

The provisions of former § 156(a)(1) concerning benefits and eligibility for retirement now appear in § 7-401 of this title.

In the introductory language of this section, the phrase "are members of this retirement system as a condition of employment" is added to conform this title to other titles of this article. Also, the phrase "by the State" is added to clarify that the members of this system are employed only by the State.

In item (1) of this section, the clause "except for a former Baltimore City Jail Employee who did not elect to become a member under § 1-507 of this article" is added to reflect the optional membership for former Baltimore City Jail employees provided for under Ch. 59, § 3 of the Acts of 1991.

In this section and throughout this title, the term "security attendant" is substituted for "maximum security attendant" to reflect the actual term used for the positions.
