

INTEREST AT FOUR PERCENT FROM THE DATES OF PAYMENT. IF THE FORMER JUDGE ELECTS TO WITHDRAW THE ACCUMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS, THE FORMER JUDGE HAS NO FURTHER RIGHTS UNDER THIS RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

(G) A FORMER JUDGE WHO, ON TERMINATION OF SERVICE, WITHDREW THE FORMER JUDGE'S CONTRIBUTIONS AND WHO THEREAFTER AGAIN BECOMES A JUDGE MAY OBTAIN CREDIT FOR THE JUDGE'S PRIOR YEARS OF SERVICE AS A JUDGE BY REPAYING THE AMOUNT WITHDRAWN PLUS INTEREST AT FOUR PERCENT, WITHIN ONE YEAR AFTER THE FORMER JUDGE IS ELECTED OR CONFIRMED FOR A NEW TERM.

(H) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE PROVIDED A FORMER JUDGE OR A SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A FORMER JUDGE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE SUPPLEMENTED BY A COUNTY.

(2) IF A FORMER JUDGE WAS COVERED BY THE CONTRIBUTORY PLAN AS A JUDGE OR FORMER JUDGE ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 1974, A COUNTY MAY SUPPLEMENT THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF THE FORMER JUDGE OR SURVIVING SPOUSE OF THE FORMER JUDGE, IF THE AMOUNT OF THE SUPPLEMENT IS NOT GREATER THAN THE AMOUNT BY WHICH:

(I) THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF THE FORMER JUDGE IS LESS THAN \$20,000; OR

(II) THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF THE FORMER JUDGE IS LESS THAN \$10,000.

(I) A JUDGE OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE CONTRIBUTORY PLAN MAY OBTAIN CREDIT FOR PRIOR FULL-TIME SERVICE AS A MASTER IN CHANCERY OR MASTER IN JUVENILE CAUSES. TO OBTAIN CREDIT, THE JUDGE SHALL PAY TO THE FUND AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 6 PERCENT OF THE AMOUNT RECEIVED IN COMPENSATION FOR THAT FULL-TIME SERVICE BEFORE JULY 1, 1975, PLUS INTEREST AT 4 PERCENT. PAYMENT SHALL BE MADE IN A LUMP SUM PAYMENT. SERVICE FOR WHICH CREDIT IS PURCHASED UNDER THIS PLAN MAY NOT BE USED AS CREDIT FOR SERVICE IN ANOTHER RETIREMENT FUND OF THE STATE OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION. A JUDGE OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE WHO RETIRES AFTER JUNE 30, 1975, IS ELIGIBLE TO PURCHASE CREDIT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

(J) A JUDGE OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE CONTRIBUTORY PLAN MAY OBTAIN CREDIT FOR PRIOR SERVICE AS A MEMBER OF THE STATE WORKERS' COMPENSATION COMMISSION. TO OBTAIN CREDIT, THE JUDGE SHALL PAY TO THE FUND AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 6 PERCENT OF THE AMOUNT RECEIVED IN COMPENSATION FOR THAT FULL-TIME SERVICE BEFORE JULY 1, 1977, PLUS INTEREST AT 4
