(C) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OR COUNTY COUNCIL FOR EACH OF THOSE COUNTIES SHALL APPROPRIATE ANNUALLY THE NECESSARY FUNDS TO PAY ITS SHARE OF THE PENSION.

(D) THE PENSION SHALL BE \$4,000 A YEAR AND SHALL BE PAID IN MONTHLY INSTALLMENTS OF \$333.33.

TITLE 10. MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS.

COMMITTEE NOTE TO TITLE: In this title, the provisions pertaining to municipal corporations that participate in the Employees' Retirement System of the State of Maryland and the Pension System for Employees of the State of Maryland or the Municipal Corporation Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System have been clarified and reorganized. Where appropriate, changes have been made to conform this title to other titles in this article. The Committee Note following each section or subsection specifies the reason for any changes to that section or subsection. In addition, a Committee Note to Subtitle 2 of the title further explains the changes made to the provisions concerning the Municipal Corporation Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System.

SUBTITLE 1. PARTICIPATION BY MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS IN THE STATE EMPLOYEES' SYSTEMS.

10-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) "AGENCY ON AGING" MEANS ONE OF THE FOLLOWING AGENCIES:

- (1) AREA AGENCY ON AGING;
- (2) DORCHESTER COUNTY COMMISSION ON AGING, INC.;
- (3) SOMERSET COUNTY COMMISSION ON AGING, INC.;
- (4) WASHINGTON COUNTY COMMISSION ON AGING, INC.; AND
- (5) WORCESTER COUNTY COMMISSION ON AGING, INC.

(C) "EMPLOYEE" MEANS THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION WHO ARE ELIGIBLE TO AND WHO PARTICIPATE IN THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND OR THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND.
