(XIII) THE TRI-COUNTY COUNCIL OF SOUTHERN MARYLAND;

(XIV) AN AGENCY ON AGING, AS DESIGNATED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY; AND

(XV) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION AS DEFINED IN § 13-1B-01(N) OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, BUT ONLY FOR:

1. MEDICAL SYSTEM UNIVERSITY PERSONNEL WHO WERE EMPLOYEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND ON JUNE 30, 1988, WHO WERE MEMBERS OF THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, AND WHO BECAME MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION EMPLOYEES ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 1988; AND

2. MEDICAL SYSTEM UNIVERSITY PERSONNEL WHO WERE EMPLOYEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND ON JUNE 30, 1990, WHO WERE MEMBERS OF THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR THE PENSION SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, AND WHO VOLUNTARILY BECAME MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION EMPLOYEES ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 1991.
