

- (2) WITH THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL;
- (3) WITH THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OR THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AS A SECRETARY;
- (4) WITH THE COMMISSION TO REVISE THE ANNOTATED CODE OR ANY SUCCESSOR AGENCY;
- (5) WITH THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SERVICE WHILE UNDER FEDERAL CONTROL;
- (6) WITH THE MARYLAND TUBERCULOSIS ASSOCIATION AS THE OPERATOR OF RADIOLOGIC EQUIPMENT UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE MARYLAND HEALTH DEPARTMENT;
- (7) WITH A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN MARYLAND;
- (8) WITH AN OUT-OF-STATE SCHOOL AS A TEACHER;
- (9) WITH THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE IF THE MEMBER IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR VESTING IN THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM;
- (10) WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT;
- (11) WITH AN OUT-OF-STATE MUNICIPALITY;
- (12) WITH THE STATE; OR
- (13) WITH A PUBLIC SCHOOL AS A TEACHER.

(G) ANY MEMBER OF THE PENSION SYSTEM WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY SERVED IN A POSITION AS DESCRIBED IN § 4-201(C) OF THIS ARTICLE MAY RECEIVE CREDIT FOR ELIGIBILITY SERVICE FOR THE PERIOD OF THE SERVICE UPON MAKING IN A SINGLE PAYMENT, THE CONTRIBUTIONS, WITH INTEREST, WHICH THE BOARD DEEMS APPROPRIATE.

COMMITTEE NOTE: This section is new language derived from the revised provision concerning eligibility service under § 4-301 of this article.

The addition of this section is based on an administrative interpretation of former § 157D(k) that the eligibility service provisions of the Pension System for Employees apply to this pension system.

This section is identical to § 4-301 except for the differences stated below.

- (1) Subsection (a)(1) is modified to clarify that service as a member of this pension system is eligibility service for this system.
- (2) Subsection (b)(1)(ii) of this section is new language to clarify that eligibility service attained under the Pension System for Employees is to be eligibility service under this pension system.
