6-416. END OF SOLICITING.

A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION THAT INTENDS TO END SOLICITING SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE:

(1) A STATEMENT OF ITS INTENT; AND

(2) A FINAL ANNUAL REPORT WITHIN 6 MONTHS AFTER THE END OF ITS FISCAL YEAR.

In the introductory language of this section, the phrase "to the Secretary of State" is added to clarify to whom a charitable organization must submit its statement of intent and annual report.

SUBTITLE 5. CHARITABLE SOLICITATIONS.

6-501. AGREEMENTS.

(A) WRITTEN AGREEMENT.

AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION AND A FUND-RAISING COUNSEL OR PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR SHALL BE IN WRITING.

(B) COPY TO SECRETARY OF STATE.

A FUND-RAISING COUNSEL OR PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE A COPY OF THE AGREEMENT ON OR BEFORE THE EARLIER OF:

(1) THE TENTH DAY AFTER THE AGREEMENT IS MADE; OR

(2) THE START OF A CHARITABLE SOLICITATION.

(C) CONTENTS OF TEXT USED IN CHARITABLE SOLICITATION.

THE TEXT THAT A PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR OR ASSOCIATE SOLICITOR USES IN A CHARITABLE SOLICITATION SHALL BE ATTACHED TO THE AGREEMENT AND SHALL INCLUDE:

(1) THE NAME OF THE CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION FOR WHICH THE CHARITABLE SOLICITATION IS MADE;
