

(2). THE SPECIFIC CHARITABLE PURPOSE THAT IS TO BE ADVANCED WITH CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS AS SHOWN IN THE REGISTRATION STATEMENT; AND

(3) A STATEMENT THAT THE PERSON WHO SOLICITS CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS:

(I) IS A PAID FUND-RAISER; AND

(II) ON REQUEST, WILL PROVIDE A COPY OF THE CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION'S FINANCIAL STATEMENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 41, § 3-204, the first sentence of § 3-201(g), as it related to a written agreement, the first sentence of § 3-206(d), and the first and second sentences of § 3-207(e) and item (2) of the third sentence.

6-502. FUND-RAISING NOTICE.

(A) TO BE SUBMITTED TO SECRETARY OF STATE.

(1) A PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR SHALL SUBMIT A FUND-RAISING NOTICE TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE BEFORE STARTING A PUBLIC SOLICITATION.

(2) THE NOTICE SHALL BE SUBMITTED ON THE FORM THAT THE SECRETARY OF STATE PROVIDES.

(B) CONTENTS.

THE NOTICE SHALL CONTAIN THE INFORMATION THAT THE SECRETARY OF STATE REQUIRES, INCLUDING EACH FUND-RAISING METHOD TO BE USED AND THE DATES SET FOR EACH FUND-RAISING DRIVE, EVENT, OR CAMPAIGN OF THE CHARITABLE SOLICITATION.
