- (e) In Anne Arundel County, a dealer may sell, barter, deliver, give away, show, or offer for sale on Sunday a new or used camping trailer, mobile home, or travel trailer, as those terms are defined in Title 11 of the Transportation Article.
- (f) [(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, in Allegany County a retail or wholesale establishment may not do business before 1 p.m. on Sunday.
 - (2) This subsection does not apply to
 - (i) food stores;
 - (ii) drugstores;
 - (iii) bakeries or baked goods stores;
 - (iv) newsstands;
 - (v) the sale or delivery of newspapers and periodicals;
 - (vi) gasoline service stations;
 - (vii) nurseries or shops that sell flowers or plants;
 - (viii) roadside stands that sell fruits, vegetables, plants, or flowers;
 - (ix) restaurants;
 - (x) lunchrooms; or
 - (xi) ice cream parlors.
- (g)] A new or used car dealer who violates subsection (d) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, is subject to a fine not exceeding \$10,000.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 133

(House Bill 246)

AN ACT concerning

Property Tax - Vehicles

FOR the purpose of providing that certain motor vehicles are exempt from valuation and property taxation if registered in Maryland or another jurisdiction; removing from property taxation certain vehicles used in interstate commerce; <u>subjecting certain vehicles to valuation and property tax for a certain period;</u> and repealing certain transportation property as a subclass of personal property.
