

Article 22 – Washington County

1-605.

THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY MAY ESTABLISH AN ADVISORY BODY TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH. THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL SPECIFY:

(1) THE COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS OF THE ADVISORY BODY;

(2) THE QUALIFICATIONS AND TERM OF EACH MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY BODY; AND

(3) ANY OTHER MATTER NECESSARY FOR THE ADVISORY BODY TO CARRY OUT ITS FUNCTIONS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 152

(House Bill 356)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County – Sanitary District – Water and Sewer Connections

FOR the purpose of altering certain provisions concerning water and sewer connections, notice requirements, and connection fees in Washington County; requiring that certain connections pass an inspection; eliminating certain requirements concerning the use of certain revenue, installation of certain equipment, and closing of certain facilities; altering a certain penalty provision; and generally relating to water and sewer service in Washington County.
