6-602. USE OF SERVICES OF UNREGISTERED INDIVIDUAL.

A PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR MAY NOT EMPLOY, PAY, AGREE TO PAY, OR OTHERWISE USE THE SERVICES OF A PERSON TO MAKE A CHARITABLE SOLICITATION UNLESS THE PERSON:

(1) IS REGISTERED WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE AS AN ASSOCIATE SOLICITOR; OR

(2) BECOMES REGISTERED WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER THE PERSON STARTS ACTING AS AN ASSOCIATE SOLICITOR.

REVISOR'S NOTE: The introductory language and item (1) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 41, § 3-207(g).

Item (2) of this section is new language that states expressly that which only was implied in the former language; i.e. there is a 10-day grace period in which an associate solicitor may become registered.

In item (1) of this section, the former phrase "produces evidence of such registration" is deleted as meaningless because it is the professional solicitor and not the associate solicitor who is responsible for registration.

6-603. AGREEMENT WITH UNREGISTERED CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION.

A PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR MAY NOT MAKE AN AGREEMENT WITH A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION TO RAISE MONEY ON ITS BEHALF UNLESS THE CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION IS REGISTERED WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

6-604. MISUSE OF REGISTRATION.

(A) IN GENERAL.
