

(4) If an examination otherwise complies with the requirements of this section, the Board may determine the subjects, scope, form, and passing score for an examination given under this subtitle.]

(e) (1) An applicant shall pay to the Board an examination fee set by the Board.

(2) The payment of one examination fee entitles an applicant to take the examination twice.

(f) If an applicant fails the examination twice, the applicant may retake the examination if the applicant pays the appropriate fee.

(g) [Unless authorized by the Board, the consumer members of the Board may not participate in any activity that is related to examinations under this subtitle] IN ADDITION TO THE WRITTEN AND PRACTICAL EXAMINATIONS ADMINISTERED BY THE BOARD, AN APPLICANT MUST TAKE AND PASS THE NATIONAL EXAMINATION ADMINISTERED BY THE CONFERENCE OF FUNERAL SERVICE EXAMINING BOARDS OF THE UNITED STATES.

(a) [(1)] Subject to the provisions of this subsection, the Board may waive the examination and apprenticeship requirements of [§ 7-302] § 7-303 of this subtitle and issue a mortician license to an applicant who is licensed to practice mortuary science in any other state.

[(2)](B) The Board may grant a waiver under this subsection only if the applicant:

[(i)] (1) Pays the license fee required by the Board under § 7-303 of this subtitle;

[(ii)](2) Was a licensed mortician IN GOOD STANDING in the other state; and

[(iii)] Meets any other terms and conditions that the Board establishes under this subsection.]

(3) SERVES A 6-MONTH APPRENTICESHIP; AND

(4) PASSES THE MARYLAND STATE WRITTEN EXAMINATION ADMINISTERED BY THE BOARD.

[(3)](C) The Board may grant a waiver only if the state in which the applicant is licensed:

(i) Grants a similar waiver to licensees of this State; and

(ii) Has standards for a mortician license that are not lower than those of this State.

[(b) The Board shall waive the examination and apprenticeship requirements of this subtitle for a veteran of the armed forces of the United States who:
