- 1. NOTIFY THE BOARD OF THE SALE OF THE TRADE OR COPYRIGHTED NAME; AND
- 2. <u>APPLY FOR A FUNERAL LICENSE IN THE NAME OF</u> THE NEW OWNER; AND
- (II) THE FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT LICENSE MUST INDICATE THAT THE TRADE OR COPYRIGHTED NAME WILL CONTINUE TO BE USED BY THE NEW OWNER.
- (3) THE SALE OF A FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT DOES NOT PRECLUDE THE BUYER FROM ADVERTISING THE FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT AS THE SUCCESSOR TO THE FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT ACQUIRED.

7-508.

A person who violates any provision of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding [\$100] \$500 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

(House Bill 417)

AN ACT concerning

Orphans' Court Judges - Temporary Assignment

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals to assign, on a temporary basis, an orphans' court judge of any county to sit as a judge of the orphans' court for another county in the case of an absence inability to serve; and generally relating to the authority of the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals to make assignments of orphans' court judges under certain circumstances.
