

(f) The sessions of the court in Baltimore County shall continue from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., if necessary for the transaction of the business of the court.

(g) In Charles County, the sessions of the court shall be held on each Tuesday, and more often if necessary for the transaction of business.

(h) In Anne Arundel County, the sessions of the court shall be held at least 2 full business days each week, and more often if necessary, for the transaction of business.

(I) IN THE CASE OF AN ABSENCE OF AN ORPHANS' COURT JUDGE, IF AN ORPHANS' COURT JUDGE OF A COUNTY IS UNABLE TO SERVE FOR ANY REASON, THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS MAY ASSIGN, ON A TEMPORARY BASIS, AN ORPHANS' COURT JUDGE OF ANY COUNTY TO SIT AS A JUDGE OF THE ORPHANS' COURT FOR ANOTHER COUNTY IN WHICH THE ABSENCE OCCURRED ANOTHER COUNTY TO SIT FOR THE JUDGE WHO IS UNABLE TO SERVE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
