

[(c)](D) The [County Commissioners of Carroll County] COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

- (1) May regulate animals that are hybrids of domestic or wild animals; but
- (2) May not regulate or control wild animals that are not owned or kept by individuals.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

CHAPTER 161
(House Bill 468)

AN ACT concerning

Fire Prevention – Penalties

FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum amount of the fine that may be charged for a violation of the State fire prevention laws or regulations.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 38A – Fires and Investigations

Section 13

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1990 Replacement Volume and 1991 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 38A – Fires and Investigations

13.

(a) Whoever knowingly violates any regulations promulgated by the State Fire Prevention Commission or any provision of this subtitle, shall be fined not more than [\$100] \$1,000 or imprisoned not more than 10 days, or both.

(b) Each and every day during which any illegal erection, construction, reconstruction, alteration, maintenance, or use continues after knowledge or official notice that same is illegal shall be deemed a separate offense.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.
