- (1) a private, not for profit, licensed adoption agency; or
- (2) a public child welfare agency 1; AND
- (2) \$1,000 THAT A PARENT INCURS IN THE ADOPTION OF A CHILD WITHOUT A SPECIAL NEED AS PROVIDED UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1994 and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 1993.

CHAPTER 165

(House Bill 566)

AN ACT concerning

Attendant Care Program

FOR the purpose of transferring the Attendant Care Program of the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation of the Maryland State Department of Education to the Department of Human Resources; requiring the Secretary of Human Resources to establish the Program, appoint a Director, and adopt certain rules and regulations; providing for the eligibility for the Program; requiring the Department to limit participation in a certain manner; providing for allocation of funds and limitations on expenditures; authorizing the Department to administer directly or contract for the operation of the Program; requiring the Department to establish an advisory committee; providing for the membership of the advisory committee; requiring the Department to prepare certain annual reports; defining certain terms; providing that certain funds shall be allocated to the Department; and generally relating to an Attendant Care Program in the Department of Human Resources.
