SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 21-501 through 21-506, inclusive, and the subtitle "Subtitle 5. Attendant Care Program" of Article - Education of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments

SUBTITLE 7. ATTENDANT CARE PROGRAM

6-701.

- (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (B) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE ATTENDANT CARE PROGRAM.
- (C) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.
- (D) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES.
- (E) "ATTENDANT CARE SERVICES" MEANS THE FOLLOWING SERVICES FOR THE DISABLED INDIVIDUAL, WHICH ARE CERTIFIED AS NECESSARY BY AN ATTENDING PHYSICIAN OR BY A REGISTERED NURSE:
 - (1) DRESSING:
- (2) PREPARING FOOD AND ASSISTING THE DISABLED INDIVIDUAL WITH EATING:
 - (3) BATHING AND PERSONAL HYGIENE;
- (4) ASSISTING WITH ROUTINE BODILY FUNCTIONS, INCLUDING BOWEL OR URINARY CARE;
 - (5) MOVING INTO, OUT OF, OR TURNING IN BED;
- (6) LAUNDERING AND PROVIDING OTHER CLOTHING CARE; AND
- (7) CLEANING HOUSE AND PERFORMING OTHER SERVICES OF DAILY CARE, INCLUDING SHOPPING AND TRANSPORTATION, AS REOUESTED BY THE DISABLED INDIVIDUAL AND THE DEPARTMENT.
- (F) "ELIGIBLE DISABLED INDIVIDUAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
