- (1) IS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD AND UNDER THE AGE OF 65; AND
- (2) HAS A SEVERE CHRONIC OR PERMANENT PHYSICAL DISABILITY THAT PRECLUDES OR SIGNIFICANTLY IMPAIRS THE INDIVIDUAL'S INDEPENDENT PERFORMANCE OF ESSENTIAL ACTIVITIES OF DAILY LIVING, SELF-CARE, OR MOBILITY.
- (G) "FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE" MEANS A PAYMENT BY THE DEPARTMENT TO AN ELIGIBLE DISABLED INDIVIDUAL TO AID IN SECURING ATTENDANT CARE SERVICES.
- (H) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE ATTENDANT CARE PROGRAM. 6–702.
- (A) (1) THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH A PROGRAM OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR ATTENDANT CARE SERVICES FOR ELIGIBLE DISABLED INDIVIDUALS.
- (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE PROGRAM.
- (3) THE SECRETARY SHALL DESIGNATE AN INDIVIDUAL FROM THE DEPARTMENT TO SERVICE AS DIRECTOR OF THE PROGRAM, AND SHALL PROVIDE APPROPRIATE SUPPORT SERVICES TO THE PROGRAM FROM EXISTING BUDGETS.
- (4) FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SHALL BE GIVEN IN ACCORDANCE WITH A SLIDING PAYMENT SCALE ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- (5) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REVIEW ON AN ANNUAL BASIS THE ELIGIBILITY OF INDIVIDUALS RECEIVING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.
- (B) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ENSURE THAT AT ANY GIVEN TIME AT LEAST 50 PERCENT OF THE INDIVIDUALS RECEIVING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE PROGRAM ARE:
 - (I) GAINFULLY EMPLOYED; OR
 - (II) ACTIVELY SEEKING EMPLOYMENT.
- (2) THE REMAINDER OF THE ELIGIBLE DISABLED INDIVIDUALS ASSISTED UNDER THIS PROGRAM SHALL BE INDIVIDUALS WHO CURRENTLY:
- (I) RESIDE IN A NURSING HOME OR SIMILAR INSTITUTION LICENSED TO PROVIDE CHRONIC OR INTERMEDIATE CARE AND WHO WILL BE DEINSTITUTIONALIZED AS A RESULT OF THIS PROGRAM; OR
- (II) ARE ON AN APPROVED WAITING LIST OF AN INSTITUTION.
