(House Bill 567)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Dump Trucks - Weight - Exemption

FOR the purpose of altering certain requirements for certain vehicles with a dump service registration; permitting certain vehicles eligible for a dump service registration that remain in dealer inventory on a certain date to qualify for an exemption from certain vehicle weight restrictions and to use certain highways until a certain date under certain circumstances; requiring the vehicle identification number of certain vehicles to be submitted to the Motor Vehicle Administration by a certain date under certain circumstances authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to require a dealer to substantiate that certain motor vehicles were in dealer inventory on a certain date; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to a certain weight and highway usage exemption for certain vehicles eligible for a dump service registration.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (g) If the vehicle registered under this section is hauling loose materials in bulk for a distance of not more than 40 miles:
- (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (h) of this section, the vehicle is limited as to maximum gross weight only by the allowable and paid registration weight; and
