6-615. CONTENTS OF AGREEMENT - BETWEEN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION AND FUND-RAISING COUNSEL.

A PERSON MAY NOT ACT AS A FUND-RAISING COUNSEL UNLESS THE PERSON'S AGREEMENT WITH THE CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION STATES:

- (1) THE NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF THE PARTIES;
- (2) THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED;
- (3) THE NUMBER OF PERSONS TO BE INVOLVED IN PROVIDING THE SERVICES;
- (4) THE TIME WHEN THE SERVICES ARE TO BE PROVIDED; AND
- (5) THE METHOD AND FORMULA FOR COMPENSATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first sentence of former Art. 41, § 3-204, except as that sentence required a contract to be written and related to professional solicitors, and the second sentence of § 3-206(d).

In item (5) of this section, the former phrase "for the services" is deleted as surplusage.

6-616. SAME - BETWEEN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS AND PROFESSIONAL SOLICITORS.

A PERSON MAY NOT ACT AS A PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR UNLESS THE PERSON'S AGREEMENT WITH THE CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION STATES:

- (1) THE MINIMUM PERCENTAGE OF THE GROSS RECEIPTS FROM CHARITABLE SOLICITATIONS THAT WILL BE USED BY THE CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION EXCLUSIVELY TO ADVANCE ITS CHARITABLE PURPOSES;
- (2) THE TEXT THAT THE PROFESSIONAL SOLICITOR OR ASSOCIATE SOLICITOR WILL USE IN EACH CHARITABLE SOLICITATION; AND
- (3) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT THE SECRETARY OF STATE REQUIRES BY REGULATION.
