CHAPTER 170

(House Bill 618)

AN ACT concerning

Allegany County – Board of License Commissioners – Employees

FOR the purpose of requiring that the salaries and expenses of the employees of the Allegany County Board of License Commissioners be subject to certain approval.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

Section 63(b)(2)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

63.

(b) (2) (i) The chairman of the Allegany Board of License Commissioners shall submit to the Director of Finance the total amount of the Board's budget, including:

1. Salaries for the Board members;
2. Salaries for such other employees as the Board deems necessary; and
3. All other necessary expenses.

(ii) From the receipts, the Allegany County Commissioners shall pay:

1. The salaries of the Board of License Commissioners and its employees on a semimonthly basis; and
2. The expenses of the Board of License Commissioners upon draft properly signed by the chairman of the board.

(III) THE SALARIES AND EXPENSES OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
