AN ACT concerning

Allegany County – Board of Education – Grounds for Removal

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Education to remove a voting member of the Allegany County Board of Education on certain grounds; providing certain procedural protections, including the right to a hearing before the State Board; providing a right of de novo judicial review; and generally relating to the basis and procedures by which a voting member of the Allegany County Board of Education may be removed.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

3-201.

(a) The Allegany County Board consists of:

(1) Five voting members; and

(2) The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, or any County Commissioner so designated by the Chairman, who is an ex officio nonvoting member.
