- (ii) Counseling services;
- (iii) Education services;
- (iv) Social work services; and
- (v) Drug and alcohol abuse assessment or treatment services.
- (4) In addition to any other provision, the regulations shall require:
- (i) The local department of social services or the Department of Juvenile Services to develop a plan within 45 days of placement of a child in a shelter care facility to assess the child's treatment needs; and
- (ii) The plan to be submitted to all parties to the petition and their counsel.
- [(f)] (G) (I) The intake officer or the official who authorized detention or shelter care shall immediately give written notice of the authorization for detention or shelter care to the child's parent, guardian, or custodian, and to the court. The notice shall be accompanied by a statement of the reasons for taking the child into custody and placing him in detention or shelter care. This notice may be combined with the notice required under subsection [(c)] (D) OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all of the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 174

(House Bill 673)

AN ACT concerning

Calvert County - Sheriff's Office

FOR the purpose of abolishing the age requirement for deputy sheriffs of Calvert County; allowing the Sheriff of Calvert County to appoint a full-time assistant sheriff to be designated as a line officer; requiring the Sheriff and assistant sheriff to be given a certain annual clothing allowance to procure and care for clothing and leather goods; and generally relating to the Sheriff's Office of Calvert County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings Section 2-309(f)
