

(iv) as a correctional officer of the Calvert County [Jail] DETENTION CENTER or in any other capacity that involves direct personal contact with an inmate in the [Jail] DETENTION CENTER;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1992.

(House Bill 675)

AN ACT concerning

Calvert County – Water and Sewerage Services

FOR the purpose of repealing certain obsolete provisions of law concerning the establishment and operations of the Calvert County Department of Public Facilities and Services; retaining the requirement that the County Commissioners of Calvert County exercise certain powers; preserving the authority of the County Commissioners to exercise certain powers notwithstanding other law in effect at a certain time; and generally relating to the powers of the County Commissioners concerning water and sewerage services in Calvert County.
