## 1992 LAWS OF MARYLAND

## Article - Environment

[Subtitle 12. Calvert County Department of Public Facilities and Services] [9–1201.

The County Commissioners of Calvert County, by ordinance or resolution, may:

- (1) Create a department of public facilities and services; and
- (2) Provide for the organization and functions of the Department of Public Facilities and Services.]

[9-1202.

If a department of public facilities and services is created under this subtitle, the County Commissioners may:

- (1) Give it responsibility for the construction, maintenance, repair, service, and management of:
- (i) Public works, buildings, publicly owned water and sewerage facilities, and capital projects;
  - (ii) Water supply facilities and projects;
- (iii) Wastewater collection, treatment, and disposal facilities and projects;
- (iv) Solid waste collection, recycling, and disposal facilities and projects;
- (v) Storm drainage, erosion, and sediment control facilities and projects;
  - (vi) Lighting for roads, highways, alleys, and other public places; and
  - (vii) Mosquito control facilities and programs; and
- (2) Assign to it any other function or duty that is not inconsistent with this subtitle.]

  [9-1203.

If the County Commissioners create a department of public facilities and services that includes water and sewerage functions, the County Commissioners shall abolish:

- (1) Any water or sewer authority created by the County Commissioners or by public local law enacted by the General Assembly under Subtitle 9 of this title; and
- (2) Any sanitary district or commission created under Subtitle 6 of this title.]
